Each year we have a short service at 6.00 pm in St Nuns Church Grampound, lasting about 30 minutes,

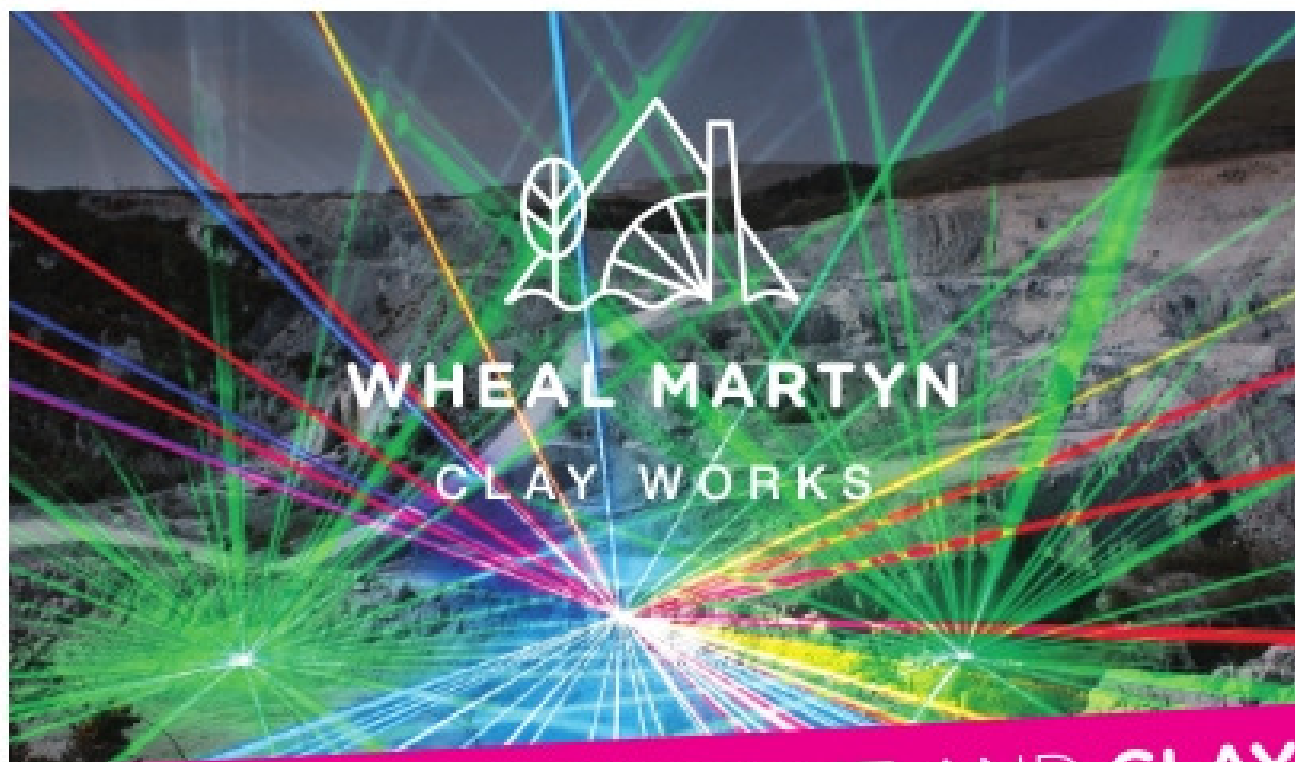
