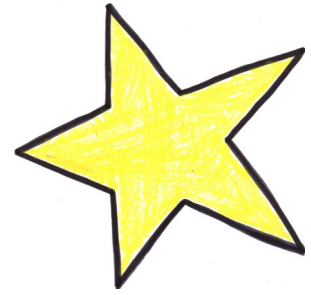

Please ensure that the school is informed before 2.45pm if anyone other than parents are collecting your child/ren.

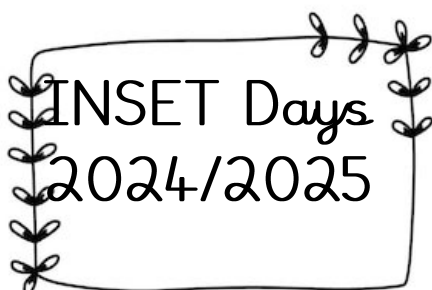

All money raised will be invested in activities for the children.

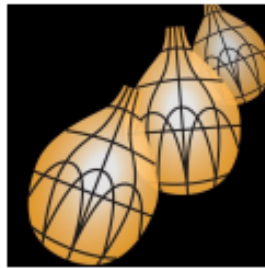
PFA Bauble Competition

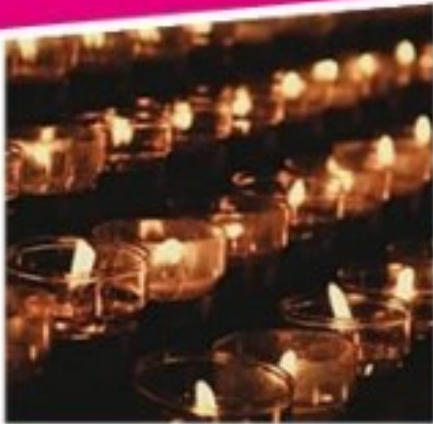
