Thursday 17th July



Summer Fete - Join us on the school playground at 3:00pm for fun, games, and stalls!







There will be no After School on the last day of term







If you are in need of some uniform we have a range of preloved items available for a donation. Please contact the office to discuss any items you need.




Please ensure that the school is informed before 2.45pm if anyone other than parents are collecting your child/ren.


