Thank you to these fantastic children for selling our poppies this week!



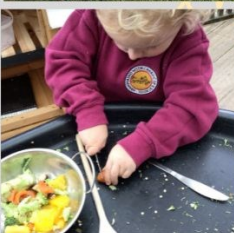

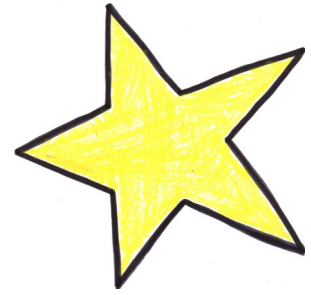

Please ensure that the school is informed before 2.45pm if anyone other than parents are collecting your child/ren.

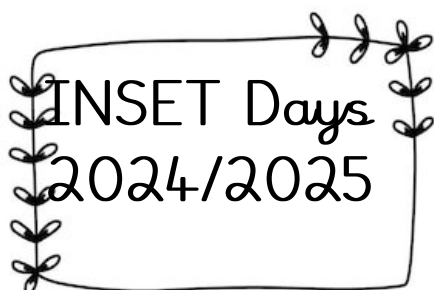
