This week, we welcomed governors into school alongside Beth Anderson, School Improvement Lead in the Rainbow Trust to monitor RE teaching and the work we have been taking as a school to further develop our vision and Christian distinctive-

All children have now been reassessed in reading, whether they are on the Read Write Inc phonics programme or onto whole class reading. Please check your child's reading record over the next few days where their class teacher will be adding their next steps reading label to inform you of what they need to work on next based on their recent reading tests. As always, we welcome you to speak to your child's class teacher if you have any questions about their reading development.

You will have seen the attendance letter I wrote to all families this week following the Trust attendance pol-

icy review and my recent meeting with the Education Welfare Officer. It is important that we reiterate the school recognises the difficulty of winter illnesses and the impact that this can have in some cases on attendance. We will continue to support families where there are specific attendance concerns and are happy to seek additional support where appropriate should health or illness be impacting attendance overall should your family require this. If your child is too unwell to attend school, we advise that you keep them at home and seek GP advice if appropriate. The school can also support families through School Nurse involvement should you feel this would be beneficial. We will ensure we continue to signpost parents to further information about attendance in our newsletters and like to thank you for your support in working with us to improve attendance.

This term we see the return of Wild Tribe within the curriculum and new extra-curricular clubs. Class teachers are busy preparing their topic planning for the new term including some exciting trips and for Pedrevan, a walk and visit to the local Church.
