Message from Ms Jarrett

Dear parents and carers,

I would like to update you of a few changes that we have made in school this week and also reassure you that these have all been carefully risk assessed and are in line with the government guidelines for reopening schools.

As many of you already know, we have now started our specialist sessions of Read Write Inc Phonics and guided reading for the year. In order to ensure that the children are accessing the teaching they need at the appropriate level (with the staff we have available), it is necessary for some children to work in another classroom for this 30 minute session each morning.

The children are seated at a social distance from the rest of the bubble, with the children all facing the same way, there is no sharing of equipment. Before entering the room, and upon leaving, the necessary cleaning and handwashing routines are followed.

This week we have also welcomed back Mr Webb to support our delivery of PE across the school. Mr Webb works in 4 small schools but only visits one school per day. Mr Webb will not enter a bubble classroom and will meet each bubble outside in the playground for their session only, and will remain at a social distance from the children and other adults at all times.

We have also been given permission for occasional visits from other professionals, where necessary. This includes our PSA, Social Care, the school nurse and our SENDCO. These visitors will be asked to use the outside entrances only and nobody will be permitted to enter the classrooms when the children are in there. Any meetings with children will be socially distanced and by permission of parents only.

There are many schools across the country and within our MAT that are having to adopt these approaches. Whilst we know it is not ideal, we are following the guidance to give ongoing support where needed and deliver the very best first quality teaching possible within our setting.

Your School Nurse

Your child can have access to a School Nurse at any time if you have any health concerns, in addition your School Nurse offers a full health assessment in reception and year 6.

The School Nurse can check:

- Your child is growing healthily and support with healthy eating
- Support with access to dental care and general support for dental hygiene
- Help with day / night time wetting or soiling
- Provide information about immunisations
- Guidance re healthy lifestyles
- Support with general hygiene issues including head lice and worms
- Support with general emotional health issues
- Support to access other health professionals
- Routines, including sleep

Additionally in Year 6:

- Friendships
- Relationships
- Development, including periods and puberty
- Access to specialist services – including dietician, healthy weight programmes and voluntary services
- Developmental issues
- Transition to secondary school
- Healthy lifestyles
