Leaf creations

Make Witch's Cat using colourful autumn leaves.

You will need:

- ☐ Lots of leaves and seeds; all different shapes and sizes
- ☐ Paper
- ☐ Glue

How to make:

- 1 Arrange your leaves into different sized piles.
- 2 Pick a big leaf or a few smaller ones and stick them onto the middle of your paper with some glue.
- 3 Use a smaller leaf for the head, and a variety of leaves and seeds for Cat's face. Try some pointy leaves for the ears and the whiskers.
- 4 Finally add on your tail and some legs!
