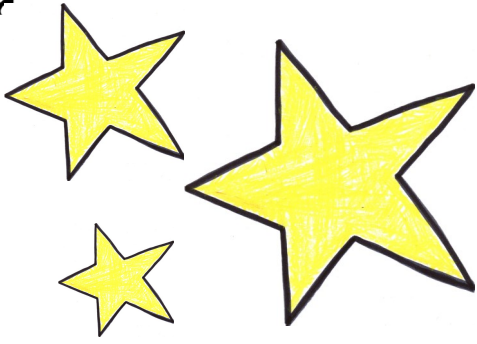

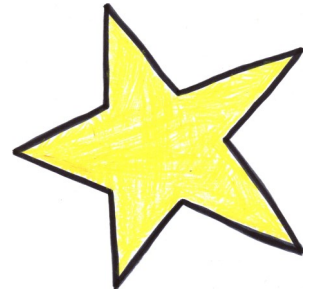

Please ensure that the school is informed before 3.00pm if anyone other than parents are collecting your child/ren.

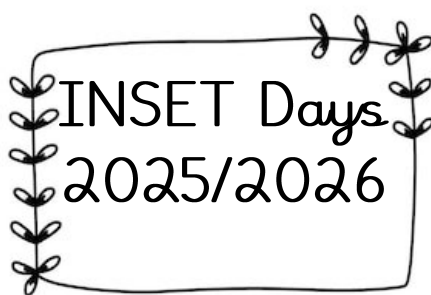

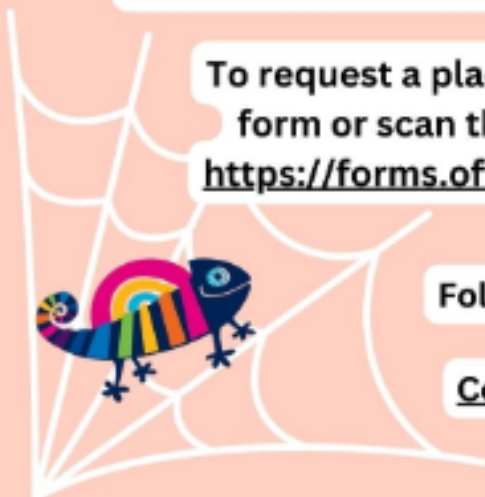
